I was very concerned to learn of the fire which broke out in the early hours of Tuesday 26 February at 64 Curle Street. Whilst I was in Parliament in Edinburgh, a member of staff from my office was on hand to assist residents and housing officers on Wednesday afternoon and kept me in regular touch with the situation and efforts to find alternative accommodation for those residents who required it. I was also in contact with Strathclyde Fire and Rescue Service and residents will be pleased to learn that the three firefighters who were taken to hospital after the fire were all released on the same day. Our thanks and thoughts are with all of those who did so much to prevent a worse situation or even a tragedy.

I understand that the events much have been very frightening for residents and that while some residents will be keen to return to normal, others may have ongoing concerns which they would like to raise with me and I am therefore providing my contact details and a note of my regular local surgeries along with notice of a **special surgery for residents of 64 Curle Street which will take place in the Whiteinch Centre from 2pm on Monday 10 March.**
